

The 2022 NDNA Education Foundation College D.J. Shults Internships

Receive \$3,500 to help hire a student to work with you this year. Here are the basic rules:

1. Student must have completed grade 12.

2. Internship requires the equivalent of a minimum of eight weeks of full-time work this year, and student must be involved in supervised news work. New this year: internships may take place either fully or partially during the school year and are not limited to only summer.

3. Newspaper must select own intern, but NDNA may have some students to refer.

4. The Foundation will pay the \$3,500 to the newspaper. The Foundation cannot make payments directly to an individual. The newspaper will supplement the stipend at a level that will result in the student being compensated the equivalent of minimum wage or more.

5. A journalism-related major is not required, but will likely get priority consideration if there are a number of applicants.

6. Priority will also be given to newspapers that have not received internship stipends in recent years.

6. Deadline for application is <u>April 4, 2022</u>. Selections will be announced in mid April.
