

The 2022 NDNA Education Foundation D.J. Shults High School Internships

Receive \$500 to help hire a student to work with you this year. Here are the basic rules:

1. Student must be enrolled in high school.

2. Internship requires at minimum the equivalent of four weeks fulltime employment, which may be spread out in parttime hours, and student must be involved in supervised news work. New this year: internships may take place either fully or partially during the school year and are not limited to only summer.

3. Newspaper must select its own intern.

4. The Foundation will pay the \$500 to the newspaper. The Foundation cannot make payments directly to an individual.

5. Deadline for application is <u>April 4, 2022</u>. Selections will be announced in mid April.
