**The United States Constitution starts out with one long sentence, called the Preamble. In the Preamble, the writers of the Constitution simply tell us what they are setting out to do:**

We, the people of the United States, in order to form a more perfect union, establish justice, insure domestic tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

**Here's what it means:**

We, the people (not a king or other ruler) of the United States, want to form a great country, so we're creating a government where the states work together and the laws are fair. We are going to be sure the country can protect itself against attacks from other countries, and that our people can live happily and freely now and in the future.

**Who wrote the Constitution?**

In 1787, 55 men representing 12 of the 13 original states (Rhode Island didn't send a representative) gathered in Philadelphia to write the Constitution. About half of them were lawyers, the rest mostly businessmen or farmers. Some of the more famous included George Washington, Benjamin Franklin, Alexander Hamilton and James Madison.

On Sept. 17, 1787, after months of discussion and debate, 39 men signed the newly-completed Constitution. At 81 years old, Benjamin Franklin was the oldest to sign it. Jonathan Dayton, just 26, was the youngest.

The document was 4,500 words long, written by hand on four large sheets of parchment paper. The clerk who wrote it was paid \$20 (about \$675 today).

**It's all in the details**

The Constitution of the United States has three parts:

1. The Preamble
2. Seven articles that define and explain the powers of Congress, the President and the federal courts
3. The amendments, or changes, which were not part of the original document. The amendments that have been added to keep the Constitution up and running so far, there have been 27 amendments. The first 10 are called the Bill of Rights. They were added to protect basic freedoms, like freedom of religion, freedom of speech and the right to a fair trial.
